

- 7 target rivers
- 7 partners
- Project period: 2019-2026
- Budget: ~ 10 M€
- Actions: dam removals, creating fish passages, restore spawning and rearing habitats, re-introduce mussels
- Target species: Atlantic salmon (*Salmo salar*), Freshwater pearl mussel (*Margaritifera margaritifera*), Thickshelled river mussel (*Unio crassus*), European eel (*Anguilla anguilla*)











Overview of dams and barriers in Sweden

- Unknown number of other barriers















